

### Library Books

Your child will bring home a library book each week. This book is chosen by them and is a chance to encourage a love for reading and reading for a purpose. This is a book to read to your child. Library books need to be returned to school every **MONDAY**.

### RWI Book Bag Books

Children will receive a reading book each week. Reading books will be sent home on **FRIDAY** and should be returned on **WEDNESDAY**.

It would help your child to read this book daily for 5-10 minutes and this should be recorded in your child's reading record. This will help build speed and fluency.

### Read, Write Inc

Children in Reception will learn through the Read, Write Inc programme. As the year progresses, your child will be able to read some additional Read, Write Inc books on the Oxford Owl Portal that they will have also read at school. This will help to consolidate their learning and develop reading skills. We will notify parents when this is up and running.
