

Year 1 Curriculum Map 2025-2026

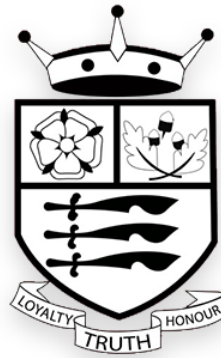
English

Writing: This term we continue to widen the children's use of rich vocabulary when speaking as well as writing. We will write stories, instructions and letters. We will continue to focus on reading and comprehension skills in Reading sessions and focusing on the features of fiction and non-fiction texts.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: We will continue to learn how to accurately spell common exception words. We will encourage children to use a range of punctuation as well as adjectives, conjunctions, verbs and adverbs in their writing.

Key Texts: Some key stories explored this term include- Goldilocks and the Three Bears, Goldilocks and the Three Crocodiles, as well as a range of different poetry collections.

Summer Term



Maths

This term in Maths, we will continue to build upon components from our 5 blocks (Number, Operations, Fractions, Shape and Direction, Data Handling). Some of our new learning this term will cover the following areas: to identify the place value in number up to 100, to solve one-step problems using number operations, to explore quarters of shapes and quantities, to use key vocabulary to describe 3D shapes such as edges, vertices and faces and to use the language clockwise and anti-clockwise to describe turns. We will also continue to tell the time to the nearest hour and half an hour.

Art & Design

This term in Art, we will be focusing on craft. We will explore stamping to create prints, using a range of shapes and textures. We will also look at artists such as Andy Warhol and Yayoi Kusama, studying their work.

Computing

This term in Computing, we will be using the Lego Builders Program on Purple Mash to learn about following instructions and algorithms. We will practise following instructions to create pictures and arrange things in sequence.

Design & Technology

This term in DT, we will be preparing fruit and vegetables. We will be designing and making a food product to help develop the children's cutting skills. We will also be learning how to handle ingredients safely and hygienically.

Geography

This term in Geography, we will be learning about our world. We will be looking at different maps and learning about the oceans and continents. Within our learning, we will use terms including equator, Northern and Southern Hemisphere.

History

This term in History, we will be learning about kings and queens. We will be making a family tree for the British Royal Family. We will be exploring the coronation of King Charles and learning about the life of Queen Elizabeth.

Music

This term in Music, we will begin to explore how music can tell a story. We will also continue to develop our understanding of beat, rhythm and pitch.

PE & Sport

This term in PE, we will be developing the skills required for athletic activities such as running at different speeds, changing direction, jumping and throwing. We will also be working on developing net and wall skills.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be exploring the topics Relationships and Changing Me in our Jigsaw lessons. The children will focus on building positive relationships and managing change positively. We will continue with MindUp and No Outsiders lessons.

Religious Education

This term in RE, we will be learning about how different faiths welcome new members. We will explore and compare how religions such as Sanatana Dharma, Christianity and Islam welcome babies into their faiths.

Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about plants and identifying the different parts of a plant. In Summer 2, we will learn about animals and explore how we can group them into five groups.
