English

Writing:

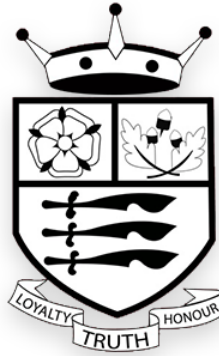
We will be writing our own versions of traditional tales and changing different parts of the stories. We will also be using our Great Fire of London topic to inspire different genres of writing, including reports and poetry.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

We will continue to focus on the use of capital letters and full stops within writing, as well as including more ambitious punctuation. We will be learning to spell contractions, as well as words that end in suffixes (ly, ful, ment, ness, less)

Spring Term



Maths

This term in Maths we will continue to work through our blocks (Fractions, Shape and Direction, Data Handling). Some of our new learning this term will cover the following areas: To find fractions (half and quarter) of amounts, to recognise regular and irregular 2D shapes, to identify and compare the properties of 3D shapes, to use mathematical language to describe position, to compare and sequence intervals of time, to tell the time and to understand and be able to use the correct metrics to measure length, weight, and capacity. We will continue to recall our learning from previous blocks on Number.

Art & Design

This term in Art, the children will create their own colour wheels. They will explore the work of the famous artist, Kandinsky. The children will express their opinions on his artwork and explore different techniques and processes used by Kandinsky.

Computing

This term in Computing, the children will be introduced to different styles of Art and famous artists. They will then have a go at creating their own digital versions using 2Paint. They will also explore, edit and combine sounds using 2Sequence.

Design & Technology

This term in DT, the children have the opportunity to design and make their own fire fighting vehicle, using wheels and axles. They will look at the designs of other vehicles before planning their own. They will evaluate their end product.

Geography

This term in Geography, the children will learn about the UK and its capital cities. The children will name, locate and identify human and physical characteristics of the countries within the UK and its surrounding seas. They will use compass directions.

History

This term in History, the children will be learning about the Great Fire of London. The children will learn about how the Great Fire of London started and the impact it had on London. Part of this topic will be the children learning about the plague.

Languages

Music

For the first half term in Music, the children will perform a chant rhythmically with actions and recognise how music depicts the weather. For the second half term, they will be learning to play the Ocarina.

PE & Sport

This term in PE, the children will do gymnastics. Later on, the children will be having 'Strength, Movement and Conditioning' sessions with Mrs Ahmed. In Games, they will be focusing on target games and improving their sending and receiving skills.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, the children will be discussing the importance of having dreams and goals, as well as learning about the importance of being healthy. They will continue to learn strategies to help with challenging situations.

Religious Education

This term in RE, the children will be learning about the Islamic faith. They will also focus on the consequences of our actions as well as learning about the importance of values.

Science

This term in Science, the children will be learning about materials. They will be taking part in experiments where they have to observe closely and draw conclusions. They will be considering the suitability of different materials for particular uses.
