

Year 6 Curriculum Map 2025-2026

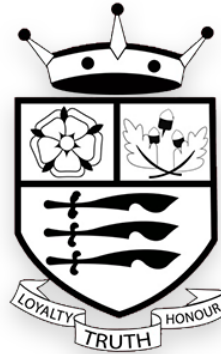
English

Writing: This term, we will be writing narratives based on Michalel Rosen's Book, We're Going on a Bear Hunt. Following our trip to the theatre, we will complete a unit of work about Wicked, where we will write persuasive arguments based on the story.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

This term, Grammar and Punctuation we will be focussed around revision of the KS2 coverage. We will be focus on spelling rules covered at KS2 and focus more specifically on the words listed in the Y5/6 Spelling List.

Spring Term



Maths

This term in Maths the key objectives will be:

- to use knowledge of place value and multiplication facts to 12 x 12 to find related multiplication and division facts involving decimal numbers
- find equivalent percentages, decimals and fractions
- to use written methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide whole numbers and decimals
- to visualise and draw on grids where a shape will be after a reflection, translation or rotation through 90 and 180 degrees
- to solve problems by collecting, selecting, processing, presenting and interpreting data

Art & Design

This term in Art, we will use the qualities of watercolour and acrylic paints to create visually interesting pieces.

We will develop a personal style of painting, drawing upon ideas from other artist. We will also combine colours, tones and tints to enhance the mood of a piece.

Computing

This term, the pupils will learn about the World Wide Web as a communication tool.

In the second half of the term, the pupils will explore the use of data through spreadsheets.

Design & Technology

This term in Design & Technology, we will be using complex switches and circuits to create an electrical board game— applying their understanding of computing to program, monitor and control their products.

Geography

This term in Geography, we will be developing our mapping and fieldwork skills.

We will learn about using 4 figure, and 6 figure grid references. When looking at maps we will use OS symbols and compass points.

History

This term in History, we will be learning about the history of rights in South Africa and Britain. We will use and analyse a wide range of evidence in order to justify claims about the past. The children will also compare some of the times studied with those of the other areas of interest around the world.

Languages

This term in French, we will continue our learning from last term; further developing our conversational skills.

Music

This term in Music, the children will learn about two topics: Growth and Roots. Pupils will learn to recognise patterns, devise rhythmical actions to music, combine rhythm cycles in a percussion piece and learn about World Music Styles.

PE & Sport

This term in PE, the children will be covering the topics: Dance, Golf Basketball and Cricket

The end goal of each topic will be able to confidently perform the learnt skills in a performance or match.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, we will be discussing our dreams and goals for this year and the future, considering our motivation for these goals. We will also be continuing our learning about the brain in MindUP lessons.

Religious Education

This term in RE, the pupils will examine religious meaning in art.

They will look at how Christianity and Islam have portrayed religion through famous works of art.

Science

This term in Science, we will be consolidating our learning from the first half of the year and performing some investigations. After half term, we will be learning about Light, developing an understanding of how we see the things around us.
