

Year 6 Curriculum Map 2025-2026

English

Writing: This term, we will be looking at narrative writing. Children will be reading *Eye of The Wolf*, which will feed into them writing flashbacks. We will then revisit writing from across the year, creating new and improved versions.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

This term, our spelling will be themed around the Year 5/6 statutory word list, and empowering the children with new strategies to learn these spellings. In Grammar and Punctuation, we will be focussed around revision of the KS2 coverage.

Summer Term



Maths

This term in Maths the key objectives will be:

- To understand the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages
- To find parts of wholes (including percentage)
- To interpret data in charts and graphs.
- To calculate area and perimeter of regular and irregular shapes.
- To find unknown values
- To use simple formulae

Art & Design

This term in Art, the children will be working to create sculptures inspired by nature using wire.

They will look at wire sculptures by David Oliveira and Alexander Cader.

Computing

In Computing this term, children will explore programming mini computers.

They will develop and deploy their own code which utilise different inputs.

Design & Technology

In DT, children will be combining different fabric shapes. They will develop the skills needed to join textiles using a range of stitches. Pupils will go on to design, make and evaluate a product for a specific user.

Geography

This term in Geography, the children will be learning about being global citizens. With a focus on using the UN Sustainable Goals, the children will learn about the human impact on the world, and consider changes we can make for the future.

History

This term in History, the children will travel back in time to explore what life was like during the 'Islamic Golden Age'. They will explore the thriving city of Baghdad at that time and discover why the city was so prosperous.

Languages

This term, Year 6 will continue with their learning in French, focusing on speaking and listening and consolidating their understanding of the topics that they have covered this year.

Music

This term in Music, the children will be focusing on preparing for their upcoming production.

We will learn the songs, and work on our ability to sing in unison and harmony.

PE & Sport

This term in PE, the children will be covering the topics athletics, handball and rounders.

They will also be taking part in strength, movement and conditioning sessions.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, we will be discussing relationships and how to look after our own mental health.

We will also be covering the 'Changing me' puzzle piece in which we will discuss the developments that will be happening in our bodies.

Religious Education

This term in RE, the pupils will examine the topic 'Religious Responsibility'.

The children will discuss coming of age ceremonies in different religions and compare their own experiences of what responsibilities they have as part of their religion.

Science

This term in Science, we will be learning about electricity. We will initially revisit our learning from Year 4, before learning about the voltage of cells in a circuit.

We will also consider and give reasons for different variations in circuits.
