- We had lots of fun at the Football Tournament and Summer Fair and raised lots of money!



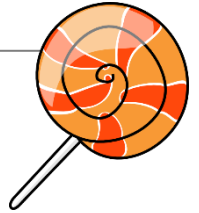
We set ourselves some targets

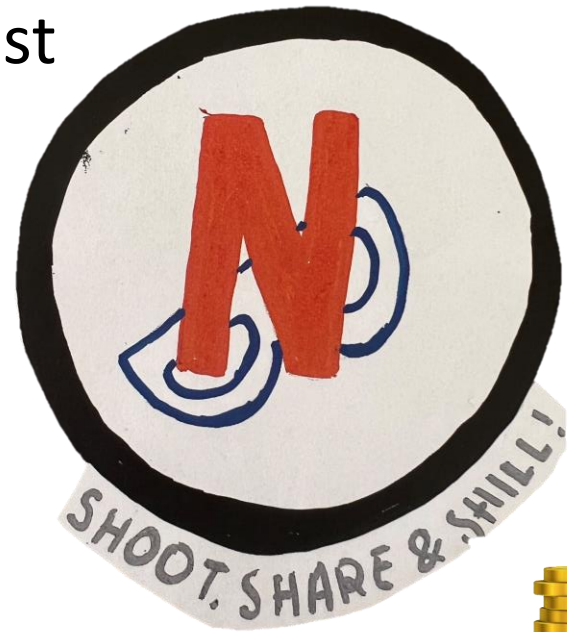
