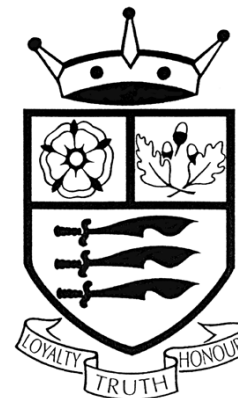


Mathematics

- 1) Compare & order numbers up to 1000.
- 2) Read & write all numbers to 1000 in digits and words.
- 3) Find 10 or 100 more/less than a given number.
- 4) Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- 5) Recall & use multiplication & division facts for 3, 4, 8 tables.
- 6) Recognise place value of any 3-digit number.
- 7) To mentally add and subtract:
 - 3-digit numbers and ones
 - 3-digit numbers and tens
 - 3-digit numbers and hundreds
- 8) Add and subtract:
 - Numbers with up to 3-digits using written column method.
- 9) Estimate and use inverse to check.
- 10) Multiply:
 - 2-digit by 1-digit
- 11) Count up/down in tenths.
- 12) Compare and order fractions with same denominator.
- 13) Add and subtract fractions with same denominator with whole.
- 14) Tell time using 12 and 24 hour clocks; and using Roman numerals.
- 15) Tell time to nearest minute.
- 16) Know number of days in each month and number of seconds in a minute.
