



Homework Requirements – Year 5

Each time homework is set, a brief explanation of the homework task, along with the due date, will be written in Homework Diaries or assigned on Mymaths. Please sign Homework Diaries and ensure that they are handed in to the class teacher on a Monday morning to check.

Children are required to complete three homework tasks a week, in addition to spellings and reading. Each task set will be explained to the children and their understanding of the task confirmed. The children will be given at least two days to complete the tasks.

Homework is differentiated and children should be able to complete the task without parental support. Please do feel free to support your child with their tasks, but the majority of the work should be their own.

Reading at home

Children are expected to read a range of fiction and non-fiction books at home for a minimum of 15 minutes a day and log the pages read in their new Reading Diaries. It is advantageous for children to read independently as well as having the opportunity to read to or with an adult who can ask them questions about the text—please look in the Reading Records for ideas to support your child. These Reading Records/Homework will then be signed at home by parents and then handed in each Monday for signing by the teacher.

Homework Marking

English:

English will be set using our Year 5 CGP Grammar Book. This will then be self marked by the children using the answers at the back of the book. At times, other homework will also be set.

Maths:

Homework will be set on MyMaths where students will receive an instant mark.

Topic:

Class teachers will explain how to submit this homework.
