

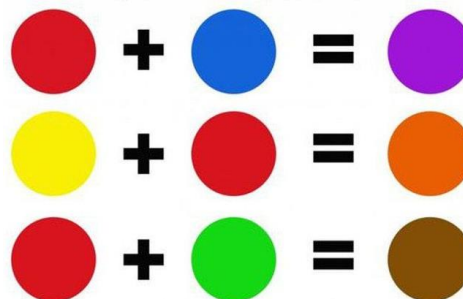


Key Vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Primary colour	Red, blue and yellow. These colours cannot be made.
Secondary colours	A secondary colour is a colour made by mixing of two primary colours.
Colour wheel	A colour wheel shows you how colours relate to each other and shows cold and warm colours.
Colour mixing	Is the process of combining two or more colours to make any other colour.
Shade	To make a colour darker.
Tint	To make a colour lighter.
Abstract	It is modern art that does not represent images of our everyday world.

Colour Mixing

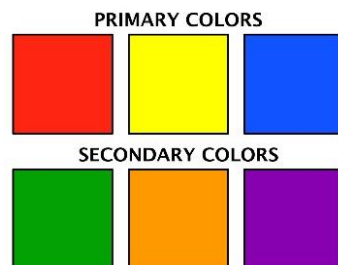
We can use a **colour mixing** chart to find out which colours we need to mix together to make a different colour. For example:



Colour Wheel

A colour wheel can help us to easily identify **primary** and **secondary** colours.

You can make your own **colour wheel** as it will help you to observe what happens when we gradually mix paints together.





Wassily Kandinsky

- Wassily Kandinsky was born in December 1866 Russia.
- Kandinsky's artwork is called **abstract**.
- His paintings are made up of lots of shapes. He used music to help him work. Kandinsky said "I see colour when I hear music."
- Kandinsky died in December 1944. He was 78 years old.
