Word	Meaning
Design	To generate, develop and communicate ideas for a product.
Evaluate	To judge how a product meets chosen criteria.
Template	A shape drawn to assist in cutting out shapes.
Join	A place where two or more things are connected together
Felt	A cloth made of fibres that have been pressed instead of woven together.
Needle	A pointed tool with a hole at the top for thread to go through.
Thread	A long, thin strand of cotton, nylon, or other fibres used in sewing or weaving.
Sew	To join pieces of fabric with stitches.

- Templates are used cut around shapes and patterns so they are cut accurately.
- They can be made out of card, paper, cardboard and other materials

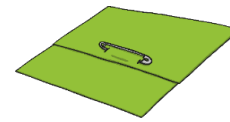

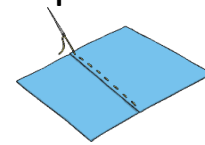
Wooden spoon puppet

Joining Techniques

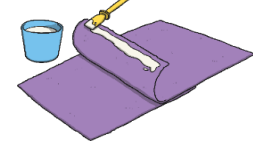
- There are lots of different ways of joining fabrics together.
- Some joins are quicker (e.g. stapling, safety pin) whilst some are more secure (e.g. sewing, gluing).
- Some joining techniques are easier to hide.



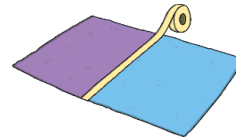
Safety Pinning



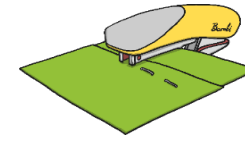
Stitching
