property	Is something we can see or feel about a material.
rough	A bumpy uneven surface.
smooth	A completely flat surface.
rigid	When a material does not bend easily.
flexible	When a material bends easily.
weak	Gives way or breaks easily.
strong	Holds its shape and does not break easily.
Waterproof	When a material does not let water through.
Absorbent	When a material soaks up water.
opaque	A material that you cannot see through.
transparent	A material you can see through.

Fabric – Can be used to make clothing, furniture and bedding.

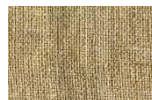
Glass – Can be used to make bottles, glasses and table tops.

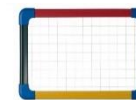
