Word	Meaning
colour	A way we describe an object based on the way that it reflects or gives light.
Primary colour	Primary colours include red, blue and yellow. Primary colours cannot be mixed from other colours. They are the source of all other colours.
Secondary colour	Secondary colours are the colours we have as a result of mixing two primary colours together.
tone	How light or dark a colour is.
artist	A person who creates art.
Henri Matisse	A French artist who create paintings and collages.

Colour Theory

- Red, blue and yellow are **primary colours**. They cannot be made by mixing.



- By mixing pairs of primary colours together it is possible to make lots of other **secondary colours**.



primary + primary = secondary

- Black can make a colour **darker**, whilst white will make a colour **lighter**. You can make many **tones** from the original colour



Matisse

- Henri Matisse was a French **artist**.
- He painted scenes from everyday life.
- His painting style is called **Impressionism**.
- He was also famous for his collages.



Making a collage

You can make a collage using a range of materials such as card, paper, tissue and paper.



You can use different methods such as ripping, tearing or cutting paper.
